Hello Sublette County, this is Albert Sommers reporting to you from Cheyenne on February 4, 2021. Today the House heard four bills on 2nd Reading, and we advanced those bills to 3rd Reading through a suspension of our Rules. We did this in order to have a final vote on these bills today, which will allow us to work out any potential differences with Senate colleagues and get them moved to the Governor's desk. The House passed 13 bills on 3rd Reading today, all of which I supported, including a bill that updated occupational licensure, a bill that reorganized animal abuse statutes, a bill that gives the State Parks division the ability to utilize fees generated on state park lands for operations, a bill that ensures property tax payments to school districts are received by school districts in time to make their recapture payments, and bill that increased fees in the Department of Health and the Department of Agriculture that hadn't been increased in decades.
